DoDEA Auxiliary Courses Activities for Eligible Students

DoDEA Schools will provide homeschool DoDEA dependents with classes and/or special education services, consistent with existing regulations and policy. Examples of auxiliary courses and activities are: Spanish, P.E., Art, Core Classes, Various Sports, and Clubs.

Access to the school library is also permitted for students who are enrolled on a part-time/auxiliary basis.

Homeschool students may be eligible to take the SAT or ACT at Lakenheath High School (LHS). Please do not register for tests without prior contact with LHS. The ACT has transitioned to a computer-based format and special requirements must be met before homeschool students are able to sit for the ACT. 
